If you forgot your password or username, or you cant get verification codes, follow these steps to recover your Google Account. That way, you can use services like Gmail, Photos, and Google Play. Tips: Wrong guesses wont kick you out of the account recovery process. There's no limit to the number of times you can attempt to recover your account. If you use an account through your work, school, or other group, these steps might not work. Check with your administrator for help. Post to the help community Get answers from community members reCAPTCHA is a free service from Google that helps protect websites from spam and abuse. A CAPTCHA is a turing test to tell human and bots apart. It is easy for humans to solve, but hard for bots and other malicious software to figure out. By adding reCAPTCHA to a site, you can block automated software while helping your welcome users to enter with ease. Try it out at . Youve passed our robot test (yes, its that easy). You can carry on with what you were doing. You can pair your Google Messages account on multiple devices, but only one computer can be active at a time. If you choose to use the QR code option instead of a Google Account, the QR code is unique to your computer or tablet. Tip: You might get charged for data if you use your phone. To avoid extra charges, connect your phone to Wi-Fi. On your phone, open Google Messages . At the top right, tap your account menu Device Pairing. If you get a prompt to sign in with your Google Account, select the account that you want to use with Google Messages and continue. On your computer, in a browser, like Chrome or Safari, open Google Messages for web. Sign in to Google Messages for web with the same Google Account that you chose on your phone. On your phone, you get a dialog in Google Messages with 3 emoji, tap the emoji that matches the one shown on your computer screen. Your phone vibrates when the pairing completes and you can find your messages on your computer screen. If you dont have a Google Account, find the option to pair with a QR code. Important: Your latest conversation threads, contacts, and other settings will be encrypted and cached on your browser. If you dont use your Google Messages account for a few weeks, youll be unpaired automatically for security reasons. When you have unread messages, the Google Messages icon in your browser tab will show a red notification and the number of unread messages. Tip: You can make Google Messages for web look darker or use high contrast: On your computer, click More Enable Dark theme. Unpairing helps keep other people from seeing your messages and sensitive info, like two factor verification codes or personal details. If you're using Google Messages for web on a shared or public computer, unpair when you're done. On your phone, open Google Messages . At the top right, tap your account menu Device Pairing. Choose where to unpair: Unpair one computer: Next to the computer you want to disconnect, tap Delete Unpair. Unpair all computers: Tap Unpair all computers. You can check your messages from your Android tablet with Google Messages. If you dont have Google Messages on your tablet, you can get it from Google Play. If you choose not to pair with your Google Account, the unique QR code for Google Messages pairs the mobile app to your tablet. Some tablets with cellular connectivity and a SIM card can send messages without a connection to your phone. This lets your tablet work like a mobile phone. After you add Gmail, the original email address associated with your account becomes your alternate email address. If you verify your original email address before you add Gmail, you can sign in with this email address. To add Gmail to your Google Account: Go to mail.google.com. Fill out the form. Click Submit. To verify your account, follow the instructions. Tip: If you use Sign in with Google or Chrome Remote Desktop and you change your primary email address, you may experience issues. I think I deleted my Gmail account If you already have a Google Account and deleted your Gmail account, you can add Gmail to your current Google Account. To add Gmail: Go to mail.google.com. Sign in to your Google Account. Follow the onscreen information to add Gmail to your account. When you add Gmail, your Gmail address will become the primary username on your account. It will be what others see when you share information, such as documents or photos, from your Google Account. Your original email address will become the recovery address on your account. To discover how images have changed over time or view past versions of a map on a timeline: On your device, open Google Earth. Search for places. To view a map over time, you can either: In the toolbar, click Historical imagery. Click View Historical Imagery. This feature isnt available if youre using the Map basemap. To enable this feature, change your basemap to Satellite. Select how you want to view the map. To turn on historical imagery view, at the top left, click Historical imagery . To turn on timeline, at the top left, click Timeline . A timeline appears. At the top right, click the timeline to explore the map over time. To find a specific time, you can either: Click the year you want to view in the timeline. Click Previous or Next . To lock the latest imagery, click Last page . To minimize the historical imagery toolbar, at the top right, click Collapse . At the top left, the toolbar remains active as a floating chip. To deactivate historical imagery, click Historical imagery . Tips: To optimize your viewing experience, 3D buildings feature is turned off when historical imagery is turned on. Satellite image availability is represented on the slider. Image availability may change as you explore. Years are marked by dots. Smaller dots indicate additional months. If a previously selected year becomes unavailable, its dot on the slider turns gray. Global coverage varies.
