It's also crucial to Verify the Correct Printer is Set as Default so that documents sent for printing go to the intended device. To do this, open the Control Panel and navigate to Hardware and Sound > Devices and Printers. Right-click on the intended printer and select Set as default printer. Additionally, Download Drivers from the Manufacturer's Website which often have the latest drivers optimized for smooth communication between your system and the printer. Visit your printer manufacturer's official website, locate the Support or Downloads area, search for the appropriate drivers, download them, and follow the on-screen instructions to complete the setup.
