This loses you your free shipping and any discount that was on the item, however, so you would only want to use that choice in an emergency. Yes, you can if your account has been in good standing for more than three months and you meet the minimum requirements for sales and seller ratings. Do I have to be an Amazon Prime member to use Subscribe & Save? No, you do not. All you need is an Amazon account. How many items do I have to order in one delivery to get an increased discount? When you order five or more items on one Subscribe & Save delivery, your discount on the order goes up from 5% to 15%. You can cancel your subscription through Your Subscribe & Save in Your Account.
