Example 1: If your partner gets upset when you forget special dates, but loves receiving surprise gifts, their language might be "Gifts." Example 2: If your partner complains about lacking quality time with you, but adores watching TV together on the couch, it's likely that their language is "Quality Time" or "Physical Touch."
