The world has once again faced the data of the Global Gender Gap Index 2024, a detailed map of the persistent gender disparities globally. This year's index, developed by the World Economic Forum, examined 146 economies, highlighting both successes and challenges in reducing the gender gap. The Global Gender Gap Index measures gender parity in each country across four critical dimensions: economic participation and opportunities, education access, health and survival, and political empowerment. Despite a modest global progress, the 68.6% of the gap has been bridged by 2024, with a projection of 134 years to achieve full equality. The Global Gender Gap Index 2024 reveals a varied landscape. The overall score for 2024 stands at 68.5%, with a slight increase from the previous year's 68.4%. Although progress has been minimal, it still represents a step forward. However, at this rate, it will take 134 years to achieve full gender equality, extending far beyond the Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) set for 2030. Northern countries continue to lead globally in gender parity, with Iceland maintaining its top spot, having bridged an impressive 93.5% of the gender gap, holding its position as leader for over a decade. Finland and Norway follow closely, with Europe dominating the top 10 thanks to high scores on economic and political parity. Le donne in Italia continuano a sfidare ostacoli significativi nella società, con aree cruciali come l'economia e la politica che richiedono ulteriori miglioramenti per raggiungere la parità di genere. Il divario di partecipazione economica è stato ridotto solo del 60,5%, con differenze marcate tra le regioni, in particolare nell'Asia meridionale. La emancipazione politica rappresenta un'area con il progresso più lento, con il 22,5% del divario colmato a livello globale. Nonostante i miglioramenti in alcune aree come l'istruzione femminile, molte donne restano sottorappresentate nelle posizioni di potere politico e economico, richiedendo politiche mirate per garantire opportunità paritarie. Il Global Gender Gap Index 2024 ha collocato l'Italia all'87° posto con un punteggio complessivo di 0,703 su 1, indicando una sostanziale stagnazione nella riduzione delle disparità di genere. The year 2024 emphasizes the importance of effective policies aimed at accelerating progress towards gender parity. The need for a global and coordinated effort is more pressing than ever if we want to see significant changes by mid-century.
